1 year: 12, 2 years: 67, 3 years: 376, 4 years: 2,107, 5 years: 11,801
6 years: 66,088, 7 years: 370,092, 8 years: 2,072,514 9 years: 11,606,077



Community cats are unowned, free roaming cats that live outdoors in our community. They can be friendly or scared of humans. They are the same species as our indoor pet cats.
